TITLE:	Motion Rejecting All Bids for Mills Pond Park Improvements – Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 281 – ( <b>Commission District 3</b> )

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission rejects all bids received in response to Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 281 for Mills Pond Park Improvements.

### **Background**

The Scope of Work for Mills Pond Park was developed based on the prioritized improvements identified through the Parks Bond Program public engagement process. The work to be accomplished under this agreement includes, but is not limited to:

- Improvements to an 1,878 square foot concessions and restroom building for the softball complex.
- Improvements to a 360 square foot bathroom building for the north soccer fields.
- Installation of ADA picnic tables and grills, trash receptacles, sod, irrigation, traffic and parking signs, concrete pads, and sidewalks.
- A new playground, boat ramp, covered basketball court.
- Parking and event stage improvements.

On May 10, 2024, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 281. The City received the following two (2) bids in response to the solicitation, which was opened on June 24, 2024.

- 1. Vercetti Enterprises, LLC
- 2. Sky Living Co. Inc

None of these firms listed their status as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise.

The bids received exceeded the budget allocated for the project. The lowest bid exceeded the engineer's estimate by \$1,704,522 (or about 61%). Staff recommends rejecting both bids and reassessing the project approach, scope, and estimate.
