A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DENYING THE OF APPLICATION BY RICHARD T. LEHECKA AND HOLLY M. LEHECKA, HUSBAND AND WIFE, CO-TRUSTEES FOR THE LEHECKA FAMILY TRUST UAD 11/18/2019, FOR A WAIVER OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ONE (1) BOAT LIFT EXTENDING A MAXIMUM OF 36' +/- FROM THE APPLICANT'S WATERWARD PROPERTY LINE PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 47-19(e) OF THE CITY OF FORT UNIFIED LAND LAUDERDALE DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS ("ULDR"), FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT, 1240 BAYVIEW DRIVE, FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Section 47-19.3(e) of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida Unified Land Development Regulations (hereinafter "ULDR") provides that the City Commission may waive the limitations of Sections 47-19.3(c), or 47-19.3(d) or both, under extraordinary circumstances; and

WHEREAS, Richard T. Lehecka and Holly M. Lehecka, husband and wife, cotrustees for the Lehecka family trust uad 11/18/2019 (hereinafter "Applicant") owns the Property located at 1947 NE 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, 33305, Property ID# 4942 35 28 0190 (hereinafter "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Applicant submitted an application for a Waiver of Limitations to allow the installation of one (1) 60,000 lb. 8 post boat lift extending a maximum of 36'+/- from the Applicant's Property line into the adjacent waters of the Seminole Lake (hereinafter "Application");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That each WHEREAS clause set forth above is true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, after reviewing the evidence finds that the Application for a Waiver of Limitations to install one (1) boat lift extending a maximum of 36'+/- from the Applicant's Property line into the adjacent waters of the Seminole Lake fails to meet the criteria set forth in ULDR Section 47-19.3 (e) and is therefore hereby denied.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final adoption.
