TITLE: Motion to cancel agreement for the purchase of aggregates - 413-10789

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission, pursuant to paragraph four (4) of the agreement, cancel agreement 413-10789 with Florida Silica Sand Company, for the purchase of aggregates, due to cause.

Background

On June 21, 2011 (Pur-10) the City Commission approved an agreement with Florida Silica Sand Company for the purchase of aggregates. On January 17, 2012 (M-09) the City Commission extended the contract for a second year. Paragraph four (4) of the agreement states that the vendor shall at all times conform to the specifications set forth in the invitation to bid (ITB). Part II of the ITB states that the vendor is required to have a location which stores the listed aggregates within ten miles of the City of Fort Lauderdale's corporate limits. Florida Silica Sand Company provided notice to the City stating that effective January 1, 2013 they would no longer be able to provide aggregates within ten miles of our City limits. Therefore, it is recommended that the City Commission terminate agreement 413-10789 for cause and allow the Procurement Services Division to issue a new invitation to bid for aggregates.

Resource Impact
