

ORDINANCE NO. C-22-52

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 26-91(a) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ENTITLED "SCHEDULE OF FINES", TO REVISE THE SCHEDULE OF FINES RELATED TO PARKING FOR SPECIAL EVENTS AT THE BROWARD CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS' PARKING GARAGE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, to address the traffic congestion and delayed entry times at the Broward Center for the Performing Arts' Parking Garage, city staff proposes to eliminate the at-entry point of sale transaction with parking attendants and implement a gateless operation; and

WHEREAS, a gateless operation requires the customer to provide payment for parking by a specified time, via a parking pay station or a mobile application; and

WHEREAS, Section 26-91(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, provides for a schedule of fines for parking violations within the city; and

WHEREAS, city staff proposes an amendment to Section 26-91(a) to impose a fine for parking overtime in the parking garage during special events at the Broward Center for the Performing Arts; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, serves a public and municipal purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 26-91(a) of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Sec. 26-91. – Schedule of fines.

- (a) A schedule of fines for parking violations within the city is hereby established as follows:
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| (1) Parking overtime (sign) | \$40.00 |
| (2) Parking overtime (metered) | 40.00 |
| (3) Parking in permit area without valid permit displayed | 40.00 |

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(4)	Parking in area posted no parking during specified hours	40.00
(5)	Parking in area posted authorized vehicle only	40.00
(6)	Within fifteen (15) feet of fire hydrant (Fine amount includes a \$3.00 surcharge for firefighter education programs.)	40.00
(7)	Within thirty (30) feet of traffic-control device	40.00
(8)	Parking on private property	40.00
(9)	Parking on crosswalk	40.00
(10)	Loading zone	40.00
(11)	Parking in prohibited areas	40.00
(12)	Parking on sidewalk	40.00
(13)	Blocking driveway	40.00
(14)	Blocking alley or overtime parking in alley	40.00
(15)	Double parking	40.00
(16)	Obstructing traffic	40.00
(17)	Parking facing oncoming traffic (1- or 2-way road)	40.00
(18)	Parking in safety zone	40.00
(19)	Parking in posted no parking area	40.00
(20)	Parking in parking spaces provided for disabled persons in violation of section 26-144 of this Code	250.00
(21)	Parking in or blocking any area designated as an access aisle for persons with disabilities per F.S. § 316.1955(2)	250.00
(22)	Parking in fire lanes Plus a \$3.00 surcharge for firefighter education programs.	42.00
(23)	Parking in courier zones	40.00
(24)	Parking by house trailers, buses, recreational vehicles, and truck tractors within the beach area in violation of section 26-131 of this Code	57.00
(25)	Parking by vehicles pulling boat trailers in excess of the maximum length as posted at the Cox's Landing 15 th Street Boat Launch and Marine Complex in violation of section 26-131.1 of this Code	100.00
(26)	<u>Parking overtime in the parking garage during special events at the Broward Center for the Performing Arts</u>	<u>20.00</u>
(26 7)	Other parking violations not listed above	40.00

SECTION 2. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall

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not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, upon final passage.
