TITLE: Purchase of Two Chevrolet Pickup Trucks - \$53,236

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of two Chevrolet Silverado 1500 pickup trucks utilizing Florida Sheriff's Association Contract 14-22-0904 from AutoNation, Inc. in the amount of \$53,236 and contingent upon the City Commission's approval of Commission Agenda Memo No. 14-1219.

Background

The purchase of two Chevrolet Silverado pickup trucks will be used to collect trash and debris; haul ladders, sprayers, shovels, brooms, tool box, safety cones, and wildlife identifiers to assist in the performance of daily duties during inspections; transport other pieces of towable emergency and maintenance equipment (trailers, generators, light towers, message boards, runway closure X's); and patrol of Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport properties.

In accordance with Section 2-181(8) of the Code of Ordinances, this purchase will be made utilizing Florida Sheriff's Association Contract 14-22-0904 from AutoNation, Inc. in the amount of \$53,236.00 whereby such contract was entered into following a fair and competitive process that included public notice; sealed, written or secure electronic bids; and public bid opening.

Resource Impact

Contingent upon approval of agenda item #14-1219, the consolidated budget amendment, there will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$53,236.
