TITLE: Motion to award purchase of Ford F250 pick-up trucks – Florida Sheriff's

Association Contract 13-21-0904 - \$150,612

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award the purchase of six Ford F250 pickup trucks utilizing Florida Sheriff's Association Contract 13-21-0904 from Alan Jay Ford Lincoln Mercury, Inc. in the amount of \$150,612.

Background

These vehicles will be utilized to transport marine vessels during normal operations and be available to support emergency services. Operations will require substantial towing capacity. The vehicles are sized to haul emergency trailers including emergency traffic lights, barricades, emergency generators, and other essential hurricane equipment.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(8) of the Code of Ordinances, this purchase will be made in accordance with Florida Sheriff's Association Contract 13-21-0904 from Alan Jay Ford Lincoln Mercury, Inc. in the amount of \$150,612, whereby such contract was entered into following a fair and competitive process that included public notice; sealed, written or secure electronic bids; and public bid opening.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$150,612.
