A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING COMMISSIONER JOHN C. HERBST AS VICE-MAYOR FOR A TERM BEGINNING ON APRIL 1, 2025, AND ENDING UPON DESIGNATION OF A VICE-MAYOR AT THE CITY COMMISSION'S FIRST MEETING IN APRIL 2026, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Subsection 3.05(a) of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, provides, in part:

[A]t the first meeting in April . . . the city commission shall by resolution designate a district commissioner as vice-mayor. Should a commissioner decline or be otherwise disqualified from serving in the office of vice-mayor, then and in that event, another district commissioner shall be designated by resolution to serve in such office.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby designates Commissioner John C. Herbst as Vice-Mayor for a term beginning on April 1, 2025, and ending upon designation of a Vice-Mayor at the City Commission's first meeting in April 2026.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
