

RESOLUTION NO. 25-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT – WATERWAY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR GRANT FUNDING OF UP TO \$4,000,000.00 TO PRESERVE AND ENHANCE RIVERWALK NORTH SEAWALL REPLACEMENT RENOVATIONS FROM ANDREWS AVENUE TO FLORIDA EAST COAST RAILWAY TRAIN TRACKS.

WHEREAS the Florida Inland Navigation District (“FIND”) can provide financial assistance for local governments within the district to provide public access to the District’s waterways through the installation of boat ramps and floating docks, as well as derelict vessel removal; and

WHEREAS the Riverwalk North Seawall Replacement will provide access to the waterways for the taxi boats that frequently visit the Riverwalk North business area between from Andrews Avenue to Florida East Coast Railway (FEC) Train Tracks; and

WHEREAS, the design and permitting work will consist of permitting a design to widen the existing ramp and to reconfigure the ramp’s staging docks to reduce congestion and provide better efficiency in launching and retrieving boats; and

WHEREAS it is recommended the City Commission approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager to submit a grant agreement for up to \$4,000,000.00. This Grant requires a City funding match of 50%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby delegated the authority to execute on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale to renovate Riverwalk North Seawall in an amount not to exceed \$4,000,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is further delegated the authority to execute on behalf of the City any other documents or instruments necessary or incidental to the implementation, administration and completion of the renovation of the Riverwalk North Seawall.

SECTION 3. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.


SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage.

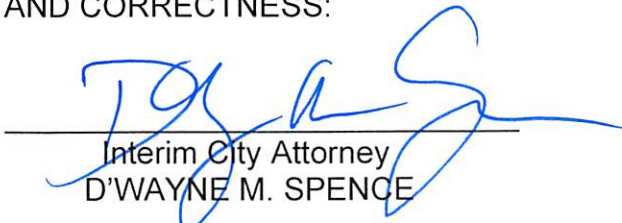
