purchase of National Aircraft Services from Risk Mondial, Inc. d/b/a Risk  
Mondial Aviation & Recovery - \$110,000 (estimated) - (**Commission  
Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4**)

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**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the piggyback agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of national aircraft services from Risk Mondial, Inc. d/b/a Risk Mondial Aviation & Recovery (RM) via the Department of Justice (DOJ) and United States Marshals Service Contract No. 15M50020DA4400006, effective through March 23, 2025, in the estimated amount of \$110,000.

**Background**

On May 8, 2023, the City received an amended final judgment on the City of Fort Lauderdale's Motion for Default Final Judgment against Defendant, Bank of Utah, granting title, right to ownership, or interest in a 2008 Agusta Grand, A109S, Serial No. 22068, N219AC Helicopter to the City. The City is piggybacking a Department of Justice agreement for the storage and auctioning of the aircraft. Auction fees under the agreement are between 4% and 8%, depending on the sale price. The auction fee is estimated to be \$100,000. An additional \$10,000 is added to the total to cover monthly storage fees of \$1,500 while the aircraft is awaiting auction.

The DOJ agreement with RM includes the services that the City of Fort Lauderdale will need for the storage and auction services for this aircraft.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(f)(5)(b), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, *the City may participate in a contract entered into by another governmental or public entity and a provider of supplies or services required by the City, if the Chief Procurement Officer determines that it is practicable and advantageous for the city to employ proposed method of procurement.*

The Chief Procurement Officer has determined that it would be practicable and

advantageous for the City to use the proposed method of procurement for proposed agreement. The proposed agreement will be made in accordance with Department of Justice and United States Marshals Service Contract No. 15M50020DA4400006 - National Aircraft Services with RM.
