A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AND AMENDMENT NO. 5 TO CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE LANDSCAPE INCLUSIVE MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONSTRUCT ADDITIONAL LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS ON STATE ROAD A1A FROM STATE ROAD 5 TO MAYAN DRIVE: PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS **PARTS** THEREOF IN CONFLICT OR **HEREWITH:** PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the 2012-2013 City of Fort Lauderdale ("City") Broward Highway Beautification Grant for State Road A1A (SE 17<sup>th</sup> Street Causeway) from State Road 5 (US1) to Mayan Drive included funds in the not to exceed amount of \$180,000.00 for professional services related to landscape architectural design and construction services ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the preliminary beautification plans were completed on November 29, 2012 and the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") plan review was completed January 17, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the pedestrian and horticultural enhancements to the commercial corridors will project economic vitality and create a unique urban environment to attract residents and tourism; and

WHEREAS, FDOT requires execution of, and City desires to enter into a Joint Participation Agreement and Amendment No. 5 to City of Fort Lauderdale Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement ("MMOA") for completion of Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to execute a Joint Participation Agreement and Amendment No. 5 to City of Fort Lauderdale Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement in connection with the Broward Highway
