TITLE: Motion Approving Agreement for Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 530-1– Fort Lauderdale Executive (FXE) Airport Aviation Equipment & Service (AES) Facility Apron Pavement Rehabilitation - Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. – \$389,193.90 – **(Commission District 1)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 530-1 for the FXE Airport Aviation Equipment & Service (AES) Apron Pavement Rehabilitation with Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$389,193.90.

Background

The AES facility, along with its 60,000 square-foot apron, was constructed in 2011. The AES houses the Airport’s maintenance staff and equipment. The apron primarily serves as a staging area for Airport equipment and can also accommodate emergency relief aircraft.

Based on the 2023 Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Airport Pavement Evaluation Report, the pavement condition index (PCI) for the AES apron is sixty-two (62), which is considered fair, making it a good candidate for proactive maintenance. Rehabilitation of the pavement could extend the asphalt’s service life by up to an additional fifteen (15) years.

The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, mobilization, maintenance of traffic, erosion control, milling, paving, sodding, drainage improvements, and stormwater protection, as well as all materials, equipment, labor and incidentals required to complete the project.

On October 9, 2025, the City, via the Procurement Services Department, issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 530-1 – FXE AES Apron Pavement Rehabilitation. On October 24, 2025, an addendum to the solicitation was issued to add a line for joint and crack repair and revise the technical specifications and plans.

The following four (4) bids were received in response to the solicitation, which opened on November 12, 2025:

- General Asphalt Co., LLC
- Ranger Construction Industries, Inc.
- Vercetti Enterprises, LLC
- Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc.

The bid submitted by Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. was deemed the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder. Therefore, staff recommends Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. for award.

At its January 22, 2026 meeting, the Aviation Advisory Board supported staff's recommendation to approve the FXE Aviation and Equipment Service Facility Apron Pavement Rehabilitation contract award to Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. FDOT has provided Public Transportation Grant Funding (PTGA) for up to eighty percent (80%) of eligible costs, and the Airport Fund will provide the remaining amount (Commission Agenda Memorandum (CAM) #24-1059).

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$389,193.90 and funds are available in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below.
