TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute a Florida Power & Light Easement Agreement for an Underground Easement Located at 1300-1350 W. Broward Boulevard – City of Fort Lauderdale – Fort Lauderdale Police Headquarters – (**Commission District 2**)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission consider a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Florida Power & Light (FPL) for an underground easement located at 1300-1350 W. Broward Boulevard for installation of underground power lines.

Background

The City is seeking an FPL utility easement which varies in width from 10 feet wide to 15 feet wide on City-owned property commonly referred to as the Fort Lauderdale Police Headquarters Complex. This easement is required for installation of underground power lines to connect to an FPL vault located on the property to provide electric power for the new Police Headquarters Complex. The sketch and legal description for the proposed easement is attached as Exhibit 1.

Resource Impact

There will be no fiscal impact associated with the proposed action.
