This is a Third Amendment to the Agreement, made and entered into by and between: CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, a municipal corporation of the state of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "CITY,"

AND

DOWNTOWN FORT LAUDERDALE TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION, INC., a Florida non-profit corporation, its successors and assigns, hereinafter referred to as "TMA."

WHEREAS, CITY and TMA entered into an Agreement ("Agreement") for Community Bus Service Financial Assistance Only for the provision of public transportation services within the City of Fort Lauderdale; and

WHEREAS, City and the Housing Authority of the City of Fort Lauderdale ("HACFL") also entered into an agreement ("HACFL Agreement") for Community Bus Service; and

WHEREAS, HACFL opted not to renew the HACFL Agreement and the TMA agreed to provide service to the areas previously served by the HACFL Community Bus program with the introduction of a new route; and

WHEREAS, the additional route requires the addition of a vehicle to be leased to TMA for use on the new route to be referred to as the "Neighborhood Link"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, conditions, promises, covenants, and payments hereinafter set forth, CITY and TMA agree as follows:

1. That the recitals set forth above are true and correct and made a part of this Amendment.

2. That Article 2, "Scope of Services," Section 2.1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.1 TMA shall provide public transportation services within the City of Fort Lauderdale at the locations and according to schedules as contained in Exhibit "A", ~~and~~ Exhibit "A-1", "Courthouse Loop Expansion," (Exhibit "A-1" shall include the Courthouse Loop Expansion public transportation service) and Exhibit "A-2", "Neighborhood Link", a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. The provision of transportation services may be performed by TMA through the use of its employees or TMA may enter into a contract with a third party to perform the services. In the event TMA contracts with a third party, TMA shall remain fully responsible hereunder and shall ensure that its contractor complies at all times with each and every term, condition, duty, and obligation set forth herein. Any changes to Exhibit "A", ~~or~~ Exhibit "A-1" or Exhibit "A-2" made by TMA shall be effective only upon the written consent of Contract Administrator.

3. For the purpose of providing the public service transportation as set forth on Exhibit "A-1," and "A-2", Section 2.6, "Equipment," shall be amended to include the following:

2.6 EQUIPMENT

2.6.1 TMA shall utilize five (5) wheelchair accessible, passenger Vehicle(s), as described on Exhibit "E" to be used in regular route service as set forth in Exhibit "A." Such Vehicle(s) shall comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and all applicable federal and state regulations.

2.6.2 CITY shall lease to TMA three (3) wheelchair accessible, passenger Vehicle(s), as described on ~~Second~~ Third Amended Exhibit "E," to be used in public transportation service as set forth in Exhibit "A-1" and "A-2" and for no other purpose. Such Vehicle(s) shall comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and all applicable federal and state regulations. These Vehicle(s) shall be leased to TMA for Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per Vehicle, per year.

2.6.3 Vehicle(s) used by TMA, or its subcontractor, to provide services pursuant to this Agreement, shall be equipped with bicycle racks or similar device used to transport non-motorized bicycles.

4. This Third Amendment to Agreement shall be effective upon proper execution by all parties hereto; provided however, that Neighborhood Link transportation service shall begin on January 4, 2013.

5. The term of this Third Amendment to Agreement shall coincide with the term as set forth in the Agreement and any renewal terms as authorized therein; provided however, that CITY may terminate this Third Amendment for convenience as set forth in Article 9 of the Agreement.
6. This document incorporates and includes all prior negotiations, correspondence, conversations, agreements, and understandings applicable to the matters contained herein and the parties agree that there are no commitments, agreements, or understandings concerning the subject matter of this document that are not contained in this document. Accordingly, the parties agree that no deviation from the terms hereof shall be predicated upon any prior representations or agreements, whether oral or written.
7. Except as otherwise set forth herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect between the parties.

The City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County Transit (BCT) are providing this community bus service to increase the number of destinations that can be reached through Public Transit. This route visits the African American Research Library, 7th Avenue Health Center, Mizell Center, Swap Shop, Lauderhill Mall Transit Terminal, Housing Authority properties and downtown Fort Lauderdale.

This community bus service connects to BCT routes 1, 6, 9, 10, 11, 14, 18, 20, 22, 30, 31, 36, 40, 50, 60, 81 and US 1 Breeze, also connecting to Lauderhill, Lauderdale Lakes, Plantation and Fort Lauderdale TMA Sun Trolley Community Buses.

The bus is air-conditioned, wheelchair accessible and has bike racks.

Hours of Operation

Monday – Friday, 7:00 am – 5:00 pm

The Community Bus travels approximately every 90 minutes, with assigned stops. Please refer to the timetables and map on the reverse side for times at destinations. The bus will operate as close to schedule as possible. Conditions in traffic, bridges, trains and/or weather may cause the bus to arrive earlier or later. Please allow yourself enough time when using the service.

The community bus will not operate when a hurricane warning has been issued.

Holiday Schedule

This community bus service does not run on Saturday, Sunday or the following holidays observed by the Housing Authority of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

BIKE RACKS

Bike racks are available on the Community Buses. Racks are designed to carry two bikes only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the bus approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

Loading

- Always load your bike from the curbside of the street.
- Lower-Squeeze the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
- Lift your bike into the rack fitting the wheels into the slot of the vacant position closest to the bus.
- Latch-Pull and release the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.

Unloading

- Before exiting the bus notify operator you are removing your bike.
- Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack. If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.

Move quickly to the curb.

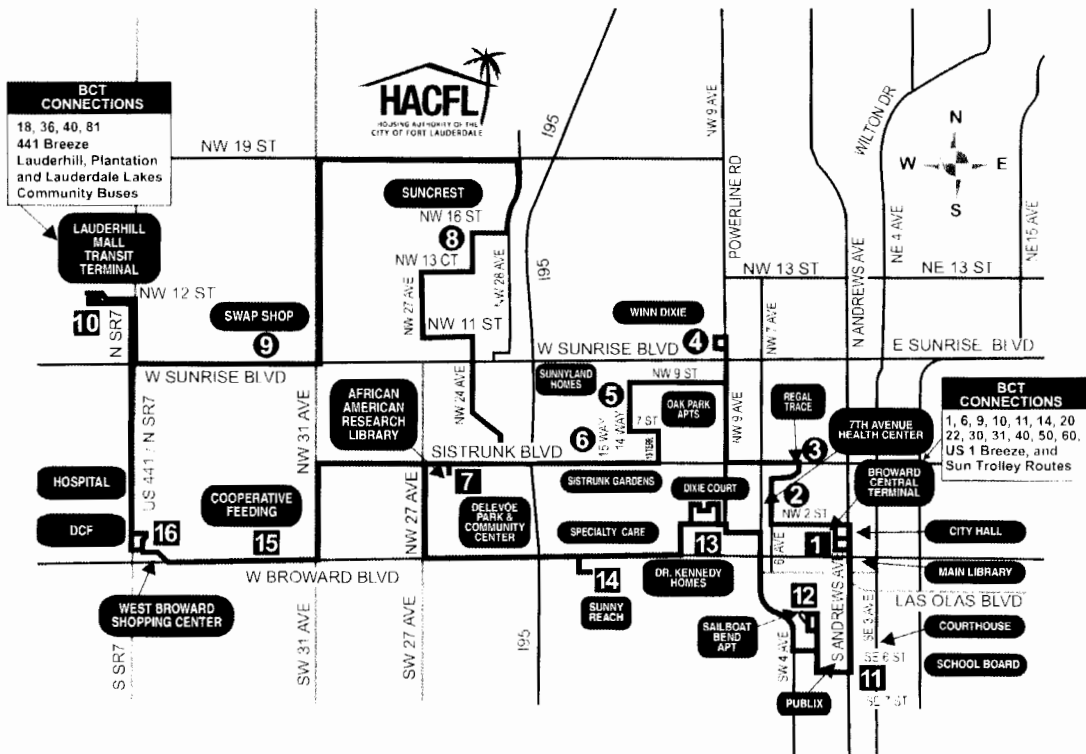
