Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a preliminary rate resolution setting the Non-Ad Valorem Fire Assessment Fee at \$328 per residential dwelling and establish the date of September 12, 2024 at 5:01 P.M. to hold a public hearing at Broward Center for the Performing Arts - Mary N. Porter Riverview Ballroom - 201 SW 5th Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33312 to consider public comments.

Background

The City Commission authorized the creation of the Fire Assessment Program to fund the fire services, facilities, and/or programs that will benefit the City in its entirety, such as facility improvements, special equipment, and cost of fire suppression operations on June 15, 1999 (Ordinance C-99-49). Annually, the City establishes an assessment rate to fund continued fire services and operations for the upcoming year.

The City proposes a \$328 per residential dwelling unit, which is a decrease of \$10 per Residential Dwelling Unit from last year. For FY 2025, the proposed assessment is \$53,590,517, which is estimated to generate \$51,446,896 in revenue to the General Fund. Based on historical information, the staff projects a 96% collection rate.

The City Manager is required per Section 197.3632 (5)(a), Florida Statutes to certify the non-ad valorem assessment rate to the Broward County Tax Collector no later than September 15, 2024.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action. The revenue estimate is included in the FY 2025 proposed budget.
