AMENDMENT #1 TO THE SOFTWARE LICENSE AND SERVICES AGREEMENT AND SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE
("Customer")

and

SUNGARD PUBLIC SECTOR INC.
("SunGard Public Sector")

This Amendment (the "Amendment") amends the parties' Software License and Services Agreement and Software Maintenance Agreement with an Execution Date of November 18, 2013 (collectively, the "Agreement") expressly as provided for in this Amendment.

Project Management: 100% on the Execution Date.


Training Fees: On invoice, upon completion.

Implementation Services Fee: 50% on the Execution Date; 50% on invoice, upon completion.




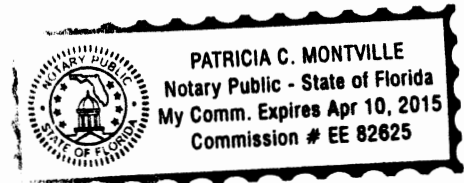

Sungard Public Sector Inc. - \$36,316

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the proprietary purchase of Mugshot Capture Station software from Sungard Public Sector Inc. (Sungard) for \$36,316 and approve amendment #1 in substantially the form attached.

Background

The current Records Management System (RMS) system, provided by Intergraph Public Safety, will be eliminated after the City migrates to the regional consolidated dispatch and records management system. The Intergraph RMS system currently includes a module that provides for the capture of photographs (mug shots) that are used by Fort Lauderdale Police as part of the arrest and booking process. These mug shots are associated with arrested individuals in the existing system and, as such, provide valuable data. They are used by the detective bureau to create mug shot lineups for investigations. The new regional Records Management System purchased from Sungard as part of the Broward County regional consolidated dispatch and records management systems does not include mug shot capability.

Therefore, in order to retain the mug shot capability after the City migrates to the regional consolidated dispatch and records management systems, the integrated mug shot capture module and workstations need to be purchased along with the OSSI Message Switch Client from Sungard. The workstations are integrated with the Sungard Public Safety RMS and this is the only product that can provide this functionality. It can only be purchased directly from Sungard.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$36,316.
