

RESOLUTION NO. 14-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTH FLORIDA REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO OPERATE THE UPTOWN LINK COMMUNITY BUS ROUTE AND DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, at the request of businesses in the Uptown Fort Lauderdale area, the City is introducing a mid-day bus service circulating from the Cypress Creek Tri-Rail train station; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and received funding from the Florida Department of Transportation to operate the pilot program from a period not to exceed three years; and

WHEREAS, the City has partnered with the South Florida Regional Transit Authority (SFRTA) to operate the new mid-day bus service; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Interlocal Agreement is necessary to detail the terms and conditions of the partnership;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the proper City officials are authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement with SFRTA to operate the Uptown Link Community Bus Service.


SECTION 2. That the City Manager is delegated the authority to make such amendments to the Interlocal Agreement as are necessary to ensure the continued operation of the transit service.

SECTION 3. That the proper City Manager is authorized and directed to take such action as is necessary or appropriate to implement, administer and enforce said agreement and all subsequent amendments thereto on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

SECTION 4. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by proper City officials.


SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
