TITLE: Motion Authorizing Professional Services for Executive Airport Wildlife
Hazard Management Plan– Miller, Legg & Associates, Inc. - \$54,010

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Task Order No. 21 with Miller Legg & Associates, Inc., for the preparation of a Wildlife Hazard Management Plan for the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE), in the amount \$54,010.

Background

A Wildlife Hazard Assessment (WHA) was conducted at FXE in 2013/2014. The WHA was submitted to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in January 2015 and was accepted by the FAA in February 2015. Based on the WHA, the FAA determined it was necessary to conduct a Wildlife Hazard Management Plan (WHMP) at FXE.

The WHMP must provide measures to alleviate or eliminate wildlife hazards to air carrier operations, be submitted and approved by the FAA prior to implementation, and as authorized by the FAA, become a part of the Airport Certification Manual. The WHMP must include all Federal Aviation Regulations, Part 139.337 Wildlife Hazard Management requirements.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$54,010 for the task order and \$5,401 for in house project management fees, for a total amount of \$59,411.
