

ORDINANCE NO. C-13-33

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SCHEDULE I OF THE PAY PLAN OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, BY CREATING AND ADDING TWO NEW CLASSES, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Director of Human Resources have recommended an amendment to the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, Pay Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission agrees with the recommendation of the City Manager and the Director of Human Resources to amend the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, Pay Plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Schedule I of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is amended to create and add in alphabetical order by class title, the following classes:

Class No.	Pay Range	M/C	Class Title
<u>394</u>	<u>M041</u>	<u>III</u>	<u>Stormwater Operations Manager</u>
<u>173</u>	<u>M029</u>	<u>IV</u>	<u>Organizational Development and Training Coordinator</u>

SECTION 2. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning the first full pay period following its final passage.
