At the September 3, 2025 City Commission Conference Meeting, members of the Charter Revision Board (CRB) requested guidance from the City Commission on any additional work the CRB should anticipate moving forward as the board believes it has completed reviews of the sections previously identified by the City Commission in previous communications (with the exception of strong mayor and requests from the City's Human Resources Department, both of which are intended to be addressed in upcoming CRB meetings).

At the Conference Meeting the City Commission directed staff to bring the item back for discussion so that further clarification and guidance can be provided on any additional work by the CRB.

The offices of the City Manager and the City Attorney will provide a presentation to the City Commission to help facilitate the discussion and obtain guidance from the City Commission on additional charter revision efforts and charter revisions that should be considered on the 2026 ballot.
