**TITLE:** Resolution Authorizing Execution of a License Agreement with the Florida  
Department of Transportation to Allow Temporary Access to the City  
Owned Property at 2801 SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue - Fire Station 3

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**Recommendations**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a resolution to authorize the execution of a License Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), which allows temporary access on to the City owned property located at 2801 SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue for the sole purpose of installing a traffic signal pre-emption button inside Fire Station 3 and to create an aesthetically pleasing finished roadway corridor.

**Background**

The FDOT is currently engaged in a highway improvement project, which involves widening SW 28<sup>th</sup> Street to add left turn lanes at SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and constructing a traffic signal mast arm at the intersection of SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 28<sup>th</sup> Street (FDOT Financial Project ID 437866-1-52-01).

A License Agreement is needed to temporarily allow FDOT to enter onto City property located at 2801 SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, for the purpose of installing a Pre-emption Signal Button (traffic control device) inside Fire Station 3 and to connect the preemption button to the signal controller. Access will include the right to access, ingress and egress, and other rights that are necessary and incidental to the installation. There is no encroachment of the signal equipment or mast arm on the fire station property. As owners of the property, the City is not conveying any interest in the property to FDOT.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this agreement. All of the work is at FDOT's expense.

**Strategic Connections**

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan* initiative, included within the

Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 1: Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal City
- Objective 3: Improve pedestrian, bicyclist, and vehicular safety
