Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of one 2013 International Terrastar truck using the Florida Sheriff's Association contract 12-10-0905 from Navistar, Inc. c/o Rechtien International Trucks, Inc., in the amount of \$59,717.

Background

The Fire Rescue Department requires an International Terrastar truck to fulfill its Chemical, Biological, Radiation, Nuclear, and Explosive (CBRNE) mission responsibilities. The acquisition of this vehicle meets the requirements needed for the Homeland Security/Metropolitan Medical Response Systems (MMRS) target capabilities.

With the addition of this vehicle to our fleet, the Fire Rescue Department will derive a primary and secondary benefit by utilizing this vehicle to tow our MMRS/Chempack Trailers and assist in transporting extra materials.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$59,717.
