**TITLE:** Resolution Approving Fiscal Year 2023 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement with Junior Achievement of South Florida, Inc., - \$33,900 - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a City of Fort Lauderdale Fiscal Year 2023 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement with Junior Achievement of South Florida, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation, in the amount of \$33,900, and authorizing execution of the agreement.

**Background**

With the adoption of the FY 2023 Budget, the City Commission approved contributions to not-for-profit organizations that support the needs of the community while making a positive impact. The benefiting not-for-profit organization is required to execute a participation agreement that provides for the maximum funding amount, terms of contribution, scope of services, and standards of performance.

The City will provide Junior Achievement of South Florida, Inc., \$10 per student for every public school 5th and 8th grade student in Fort Lauderdale, served annually through JA BizTown and JA Finance Park. Junior Achievement inspires over 50,000 students per year by providing financial and entrepreneurial learning in the public schools of Broward County, Florida, including those in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

**Resource Impact**

There is a fiscal impact to the General Fund in the amount of \$33,900 in FY 2023. Funding is budgeted and available in the account listed on the following page.
