**TITLE**: Resolution Approving the First Amendment to Scholarship Fund Agreement

with Broward Education Foundation for Funding of Twelve Student Scholarships to be Divided between Six Fort Lauderdale Public High

Schools – (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

## **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute the First Amendment to the Scholarship Fund Agreement with the Broward Education Foundation to allocate \$13,300 to fund twelve (12) scholarships, two (2) scholarships for each of the six (6) public high schools in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Scholarships will be in partnership with the Broward Education Foundation as follows:

- 12 Florida Pre-Paid Scholarships awarded for 30 Credit Hours (1 year).
- The award amount is \$12,800
- Fee for service is \$500.00
- Scholarship Value is \$38,098.80.

## **Background**

On March 4, 2025, the City Commission approved Resolution No. 25-34 authorizing the City Manager to execute a Scholarship Fund Agreement with the Broward Education Foundation to fund twelve (12) scholarships, two (2) scholarships for each of the six (6) public high schools in the City of Fort Lauderdale. The scholarships were awarded to 12 students from Dillard 6-12 High School, Fort Lauderdale High School, Seagull Alternative High School, Sheridan Technical High School, Stranahan High School, and Whiddon-Rogers Education Center in September of 2025. The First Amendment is to provide scholarships for the class of 2026.
