A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE'S FY 2024 FINAL ALL FUNDS BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2023, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2024, AS AMENDED, BY APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS AS SET FORTH IN CITY COMMISSION AGENDA MEMO #23-0987, AMENDING THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FINAL FY 2024 - FY 2028 COMMUNITY INVESTMENT PLAN FOR THE FISCAL YEARS BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2023, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2028, AS AMENDED, BY APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS AS SET FORTH IN CITY COMMISSION AGENDA MEMO #23-0987, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 23-194, adopted on September 13, 2023, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, adopted the City of Fort Lauderdale's FY 2024 Final All Funds Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 23-184, adopted on September 13, 2023, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, adopted the City of Fort Lauderdale Final FY 2024 - FY 2028 Community Investment Plan for the Fiscal Years beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2028;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City of Fort Lauderdale's FY 2024 Final All Funds Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2024, as amended, is hereby amended by appropriating and transferring funds as set forth in City Commission Agenda Memo #23-0987, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City of Fort Lauderdale Final FY 2024 - FY 2028 Community Investment Plan for the Fiscal Years beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2028, as amended, to the extent appropriated for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2024, is hereby amended by appropriating and transferring funds as set forth in City Commission Agenda Memo #23-0987.

RESOLUTION NO. 23-238

That if any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid SECTION 3. or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution amending the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Operating Budget and FY 2024 – FY 2028 Community Investment Plan (CIP).

Background

Examples of recommended actions within the budget amendment are:

- transfer between funds;
- transfer between capital and operating budgets;
- · transfer between capital projects;
- acceptance and appropriation of grant funding;
- · amendment to staffing level;
- · appropriation from fund balance; and
- appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures.

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2024 Final Budget, and FY 2024 – FY 2028 Community Investment Plan, as revised, by approving the following transfer and appropriations:

Public Works/Finance

A. Appropriation of Loan Proceeds – Water and Sewer Operations Fund, Water & System Line of Credit Capital Projects Fund – Water & Sewer System Line of Credit - \$200,000,000

The purpose of this budget amendment is to appropriate funds to provide interim financing in the form of the Water and Sewer System – Line of Credit (LOC). The securing of the LOC, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000,000, is recommended to finance the costs for the development, design, acquisition, construction, extension, improvement, equipping and furnishing of water and sewer improvements within the City.

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2024 Operating Budget and FY 2024 – FY 2028 Community Investment Plan in the amount of \$200,000,000 for the interim financing of the Water and Sewer System Line of Credit. There are corresponding CAMs 23-0822, 23-0823 and 23-0984.

B. Transfer between Capital and Operating Budgets – General Capital Projects Fund, General Fund – Central City Holiday Lights - \$7,907.91

The District Two Commission Office has indicated a desire to contribute the balance remaining in the District II Parks project to provide funding for Central City Alliance, Inc.'s public-facing winter-Holiday-related lighting and/or other decorations.

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2024 Operating Budget and FY 2024 – FY 2028 Community Investment Plan in the amount of \$7,907.91 to provide funding for Central City Beach Alliance, Inc.'s public-facing winter-Holiday-related lighting and/or other decorations. There is an associated CAM 23-0989.
