Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission to adopt a resolution to create a Citizens Advisory Board (Board) to assist with the selection of candidates for the City Manager position and provide a short list of candidates for review to the City Commission.

Background

At the May 22nd, 2024, City Commission Conference Meeting, the City Commission discussed the establishment of a Board to select candidates to recommend to the City Commission for a new City Manager.

The City Commission requested that the Board be comprised of seven (7) members. Each member of the City Commission shall appoint one (1) member. There shall be two (2) consensus appointments:

- 1. One member shall be recommended from and by the Council of Civic Association.
- 2. One member of the City's business community.

The purpose and duties of the Citizens Advisory Board include advising the City Commission on matters related to the hiring of a City Manager, consider community concerns and recommendations, and review resumes provided by an outside consultant and prepare a short list of candidates for further consideration. A more detailed list of the Board's purpose and duties is more clearly defined in the attached resolution (Exhibit 1).
