TITLE: Motion to Approve an Amendment to the Event Agreement and Related
Road Closings with Strictly Local, Inc. for Food in Motion: Flagler Village
Green Market

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an amended event agreement and related road closings with Strictly Local, Inc. and authorize execution of the agreement by the City Manager. If the Commission is in agreement with the applicants' requests for extended hours, a separate motion of a time certain should be made.

Background

City staff has been working closely with the event organizer regarding event topics, such as logistics, maintenance, and security as detailed below. The Police Department recommends approval of the closing of the City streets where appropriate, and event parking has been satisfactorily arranged. When applicable, amplified music was discussed and event organizers were advised of the noise ordinance and possible concerns.

The organizer will pay for all event costs and submit the required certificates of insurance. The event organizer will also secure all other necessary permits and licenses that are required from other agencies. Civic and merchant associations have been notified as appropriate regarding events in their areas. Specific event details are included in each event application as attached.

Where applicable, the City Commission authorizes amplified music for the events listed below.

Authorization for the execution of the event agreement is contingent upon the City Attorney's Office receiving and approving a validly executed agreement.

An application for Food in Motion: Flagler Village Green Market was approved at the June 20, 2017 Commission Meeting, however the applicant listed the incorrect date. The actual date is Friday, July 14, 2017. The application has been amended with the

correct date and is being brought back to Commission for approval.

Effective October 1, 2015 the City began to enforce the noise requirements outlined in Exhibit 1.
