TITLE: Motion to approve first renewal of agreement for Architectural-
Engineering Services contract – 616-10754- \$50,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a one-year renewal of agreement for Architectural-Engineering services with Zyscovich, Inc. and authorize the execution of the renewal agreement in substantially the form attached.

Background

On February 15, 2011 the Community Redevelopment Agency Board of Directors authorized staff to advertise for firms to provide Architectural – Engineering Services for the Redevelopment of the Sebastian/Alhambra parking lot facility project and Oceanside parking lot facility project subject to the requirements of the Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act.

On November 1, 2011 the City Commission approved the selection of the highest ranked consultant, Zyscovich, Inc. The initial two-year agreement was approved by the City Commission on February 21, 2012. In accordance with the agreement terms this renewal is the first of three renewal options which will allow the continuance of exploring the development of the Oceanside parking lot facility.

Resource Impact

Purchases are made on an as-needed basis and charged to individual budgets per available funds and in accordance with negotiated fees.
