The ATC-106 is the standard in the industry with its ability to be self-supporting, self-guying or even fully guyed to the ground when the payload and wind requirements require. The tower is comprised of six 21 foot tower sections manufactured at our facility. The tower sections are then hot dipped galvanized for the ultimate in protection against the elements. The tower sections can also be painted for FAA purposes, if necessary. The tower is tilted via a robust cable and winch system. This method has been field proven over the past 25 years. The tower is telescoped with a direct drive gearbox manufactured specifically for Alltech by world leader Boston Gear. The gearbox turns a cable drum which has 3/8 GAC 7x19 cable to lift the 2nd tower section. The upper tower sections are lifted by the one below it and all tower sections have a redundancy of three(3) 5/16 GAC 7x19 or ¼ GAC 7x19 cables per section. All cabling is “Aircraft Quality Cable”. The tower system has multiple safety limit switches to prevent the tower from being extended or retracted beyond the safe limits. Sheaves are constructed of solid steel (or stainless) for extra strength and durability. All bolts used are made from the highest quality Grade 5 or Grade 8 strength. AllTech follows AWS D1.1 Welding Procedures.

Once the tower is deployed a mechanical locking mechanism can be engaged for further safety. Additionally, there are optional manual tower lockouts that can be installed when the tower is at ANY deployed height.

Alltech manufactures the trailer at the same time the tower sections are being built. Therefore, if there are any customer specific requirements for equipment placement, Alltech can accommodate these requests. The trailer is an extra heavy-duty trailer designed and engineered specifically for the ATC-106 tower system. We do not use commercial trailers built by another company for another original purpose. At the same time we are building the trailer, the outriggers and tower base are being built. Alltech uses MIL-STD 1791 as a guide for shock and vibration protection and follows AWS D1.1 Welding Procedures.

The trailer is 100% steel and hot dipped galvanized and will last virtually forever compared to painted, powder coated or other coated trailers. The trailer is supported by two 7,000 lb axles, both with electric brakes. The base weight of the trailer is 8,300 lbs so that leaves 5,700 lbs of available equipment weight. This is the most in the industry. The trailer is DOT compliant with LED lighting and a brake away kit and safety chains. A 2 5/16 coupler is standard but pintle and gooseneck options are also available.

The outriggers on the ATC-106 are far superior to the standard outriggers that slide from beneath the trailer and are made of square tubing. The Alltech outriggers are attached to the tower base and provide the maximum support to the tower structure itself. The outriggers easily swing out and lock in place for safety. The outriggers that are beneath the trailer are difficult to pull out and often rust and seize up.

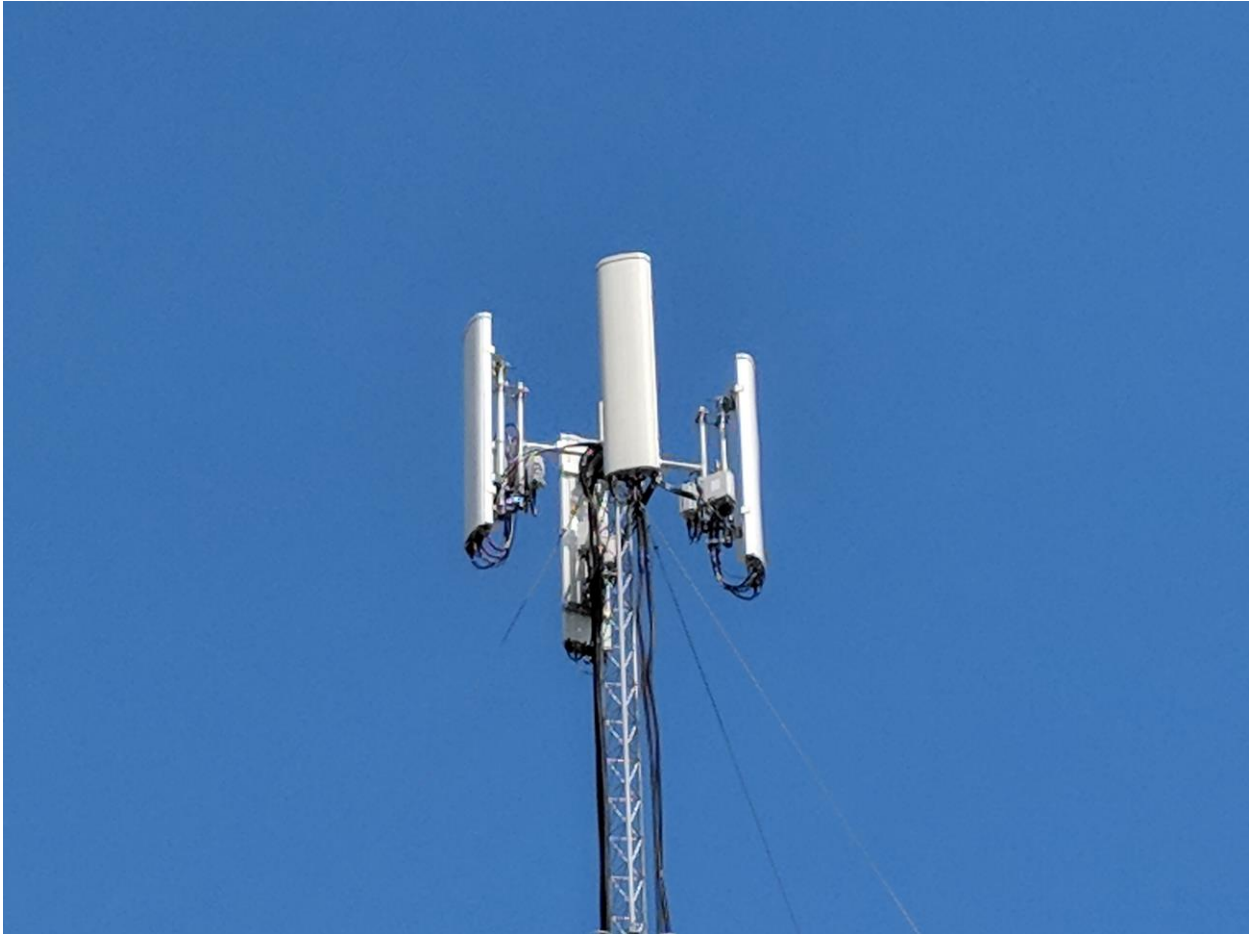
