TITLE: Motion to award a one-year contract for compound and fire service water

meters - Invitation to Bid (ITB) 442-11459 - \$138,663

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a one-year contract for the purchase of compound and fire service water meters to the single bidder, HD Supply Waterworks, LTD. (HD), in the estimated annual amount of \$138,663 and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

Public Works Utilities Distribution and Collection staff maintains over 770 miles of water distribution lines throughout the City. Part of this maintenance requires the installation and replacement of compound and fire service water meters. This contract affords staff the opportunity to procure meters as needed. The Sensus brand meter is exclusively used in the City to limit part inventory and allow ease of maintenance.

The Procurement Services Division sent an ITB to 441 vendors. The bid was originally scheduled to open on August 19th. Only one bid had been received, so the bid opening date was extended until August 29th in hopes of acquiring additional bids. Staff called various vendors that had viewed the bid and not responded to find out why they had not responded. The City was informed that HD is the only authorized distributor for Sensus water meters in Southern Florida and no other bids would be submitted.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$138,663.
