

RESOLUTION NO. 17-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE FIVE-YEAR COMMUNITY INVESTMENT PLAN, AS AMENDED, FOR FY 2018 – FY 2022.

WHEREAS, the Five-Year Community Investment Plan (CIP) is an integral part of the City of Fort Lauderdale's budget and is in recognition of the need to have a comprehensive and financially balanced plan; and

WHEREAS, at the July 11, 2017 regular meeting of the City Commission, the City Commission reviewed the proposed CIP for FY 2018 – FY 2022; and

WHEREAS, the unspent CIP project balances at the end of FY 2017 is considered a part of the five year total and is hereby re-appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the CIP Plan is included as part of the FY 2018 Tentative Budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Tentative Five-Year CIP, as amended, for FY 2018 – FY 2022, submitted for consideration to the City Commission together with this Resolution, is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
