TITLE: Motion Approving Fiscal Year 2026 Beach Business Improvement District

(BBID) Grant Participation Agreement with Winterfest, Inc. for the Parade

Viewing Area - \$25,000 - (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the Fiscal Year 2026 Beach Business Improvement District (BBID) Grant Participation Agreement with Winterfest, Inc., in substantially the form attached, to support the Seminole Hard Rock Winterfest Boat Parade Viewing Area as a destination marketing activation on December 13, 2025, in the amount of \$25,000.

Background

At its May 12, 2025, meeting, as part of the annual event grant application review, the Beach Business Improvement District (BBID) Advisory Committee considered a request from Winterfest, Inc. for \$25,000 in sponsorship funding for Fiscal Year 2026. The BBID Advisory Committee unanimously recommended approval by a vote of 8 to 0 (Exhibit 1).

BBID is sponsoring the Seminole Hard Rock Winterfest Boat Parade Viewing Area as part of the broader Winterfest Boat Parade, a 54-year tradition in Fort Lauderdale. The twelve (12)-mile parade begins on the New River and travels north along the Intracoastal Waterway to Pompano Beach, passing by the largest public viewing area on Fort Lauderdale's barrier island, the Las Olas Intracoastal Promenade Park. The parade viewing area includes bleacher seating with live narration and site activations including music, food and beverage vendors, sponsor activations, and children's activities.

The Seminole Hard Rock Winterfest Boat Parade generates significant destination marketing value by extending the City's brand visibility and strengthening its competitive position within the travel and hospitality marketplace. In 2024, the BBID benefited from an estimated \$3 million advertising campaign across television, digital, social media, email, radio, print and direct mail, targeting out-of-state, regional and local markets. This partnership delivers substantial media exposure, enhances the visitor experience, and reinforces Fort Lauderdale's image as a vibrant, must-visit destination. BBID funding will

be used to supplement event production and marketing expenses associated with this event. The BBID Grant Application provides additional event details (Exhibit 2).

Funding History

Winterfest, Inc. has received funding from the BBID since 2022 for a total amount of \$90,000.

Resource Impact

There is a Fiscal Year 2026 fiscal impact to the City, via the BBID, in the amount of \$25,000 in the account listed below.
