TITLE: Motion to 1) Amend three unit priced annual contracts for storm drainage services with GPE Engineering & General Contractor Corp., secondary contractor Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc., and tertiary contractor Ric-Man Construction Florida Inc., to include additional projects throughout the City on an as needed basis pending budget availability and 2) Approve Work Orders No. 4 and No. 5 with GPE Engineering & General Contractor Corp. under the Annual Storm Drainage contract for the following drainage improvement projects:

- a) Work Order No. 4 – Holiday Park Jimmy Evert Tennis Center (Project 11743, \$79,699.01)
- b) Work Order No. 5 – SW 13 Street between SW 8th and 9th Avenues (Project 11780G, \$92,433.43), and Belmar Street between Breakers Avenue and A1A – (Project 11780O, \$42,920.72)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the amendment of the Annual Storm Drainage contract (11780) with GPE Engineering & General Contractor Corp., secondary contractor Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc., and tertiary contractor Ric-Man Construction Florida Inc., to include additional storm projects in the City on an as needed basis pending budget availability, and approve Work Orders No. 4 and No. 5 with GPE Engineering & General Contractor Corp. for the following drainage projects:

1. Drainage project 11743 (Exhibit 1) – Holiday Park Jimmy Evert Tennis Center in the total amount of \$79,699.01 (\$73,795.38 plus \$5,903.63 (8%) for construction service fees)
2. Drainage project 11780G (Exhibit 2) – SW 13 Street, between SW 8th and 9th Avenues in the total amount of \$92,433.43 (\$84,033.43 plus \$8,400 (10%) for construction fees and contingencies)

3. Drainage project 11780O (Exhibit 3) – Belmar Street between Breakers Avenue and A1A, in the total amount of \$42,920.72 (\$39,020.72 plus \$3,900 (10%) for construction fees and contingencies

Work Orders under this contract in a cumulative amount over \$25,000 will be brought back to the City Commission for approval in compliance with Section 2-179(5) of the Code of Ordinances.

Background

On January 8, 2013, the City Commission awarded an Annual Contract for construction of various storm drainage projects throughout the City. Projects include the restoration, testing and installation of storm pipelines, storm basins and manholes, exfiltration trenches, storm drainage wells and other storm water drainage components. The amendment of the contract is needed to undo the original language in CAM 12-2514 limiting projects to only the projects shown in Exhibit 4.

Work Order No. 4 is for the installation of new storm inlets, pipe, concrete curbing and exfiltration trenches within the Holiday Park Jimmy Evert Tennis Center, and encompasses work items defined in the Annual Storm Contract. GPE's proposal (see Exhibit 1) is based on unit price costs negotiated in the Annual Contract.

Work Order No. 5 is for two projects listed in the 2012/2013 Annual Storm Drainage Contract, 11780G (SW 13 Street) and 11780O (Belmar Street) (see Exhibit 4). For both projects, stormwater street runoff goes into private garages, and for 11780G (SW 13 Street site), the water level reaches the buildings finished floor elevation as it is the lowest point within the general topography of that area.

Construction of the above projects will alleviate stormwater flooding in the respective neighborhoods.

Resource Impact

There is an estimated fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$79,699.01, appropriated in the PKR062901-3434 fund from the Parks and Recreation Department for Work Order No. 4. with an available funding amount of \$100,000.

There is an estimated fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$135,354.15 for Work Order No. 5 (\$92,433.43 for P11780G and associated engineering fees plus \$42,920.72 for P11780O and associated engineering fees) from current funds appropriated in the Stormwater Capital Fund. Work Orders will be issued based on the available contract funding and per approved Annual Storm Contract unit prices.
