TITLE: Public Hearing to consider approving the FY 2014 Sunrise Key
Neighborhood Improvement District's Proposed Millage Rate and Tentative
Budget

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission hold a Public Hearing and adopt a resolution to accept and adopt the FY 2014 Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District's Proposed Millage Rate and Tentative Budget.

Background

Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District (SKNID) is a local government neighborhood improvement district created by Ordinance C-92-12 in accordance with Florida State Statute Section 163.506. The district is authorized to levy ad valorem tax on real and personal property up to two mills annually to generate revenue to provide security services. The revenue is collected via tax bills by the Broward County Records, Taxes, and Treasury Division and electronically transmitted to the City. The funds are set-aside in a trust account for the district and are subsequently reimbursed to the district on an as needed basis.

The Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District set its millage rate at 1.0000 mill and established its budget of \$75,000 at its May 22, 2013 meeting. The millage rate will not generate enough revenue to fund the district's operational budget; therefore, the district has requested funds in the amount of \$613 to be used from its fund balance to meet the shortfall.

Resource Impact
