TITLE: 2023 Legislative Update - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

The 2023 State Regular Legislative Session ("Session") commenced on March 7, 2023 in Tallahassee, Florida. Session is held annually for 60-days each year. This year Session is scheduled to end on May 5, 2023. Prior to Session, the City Commission adopted the 2023 State Legislative Program, which identifies the Commission fundamental principles, resolutions, legislative priorities, and appropriation priorities. The final bill report contains a comprehensive list of bills that were monitored. In addition to the state update, a brief federal update will also be provided.
