



# HISTORY OF PROJECT

*Fort Lauderdale has a rich history with swimming dating back to 1928 with the opening of the Casino Pool, the first Olympic Size swimming pool in the state of Florida.*

*The landmark renovation project includes four swimming pools (training pool, Competition pool, dive pool, and spa) and support amenities that will welcome new generations of aquatic sport enthusiasts.*

- **August 21, 2018:** Design-build contract for the renovation of FLAC awarded to Hensel Phelps Construction Company for \$27,000,000
- **April 5, 2019:** The City celebrated with a ground-breaking ceremony
- **July 1, 2021:** 27-Meter Dive Tower Dedication
- **June 6, 2022:** Media Day – first divers off the 27M tower
- **September 12, 2022:** Opening Day
- **December 24, 2022:** Final Completion Date

# EXPENDITURES & TOTAL COST

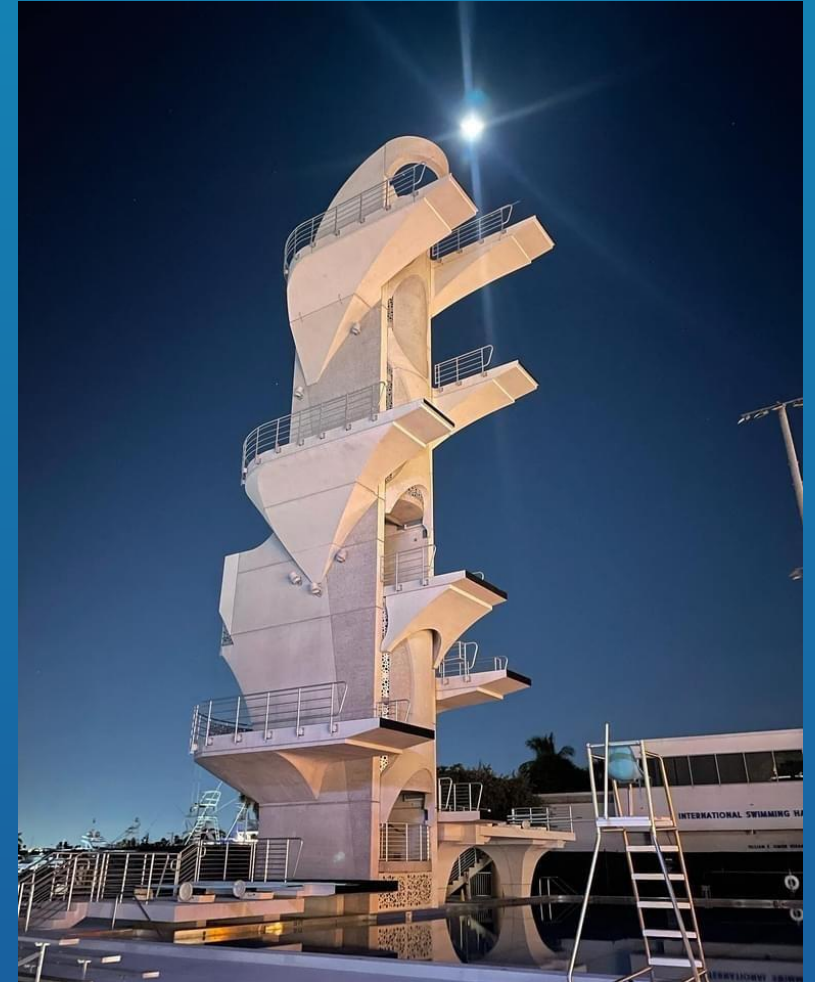
## Base Project, P12315: \$34,870,261

- August 21, 2018, a design-build contract for the renovation of the Fort Lauderdale Aquatic Center was awarded to Hensel Phelps Construction Company for \$27,000,000
- July 7, 2020: \$7,870,261 was approved for the construction of a 27-meter dive tower & a north observation deck
- 27M Dive Tower: \$5,101,060 CRA Funds
- Observation Deck: \$2,769,201 Park Impact Fees

## South Building, P12582: \$9,850,000

- Under a separate P3 contract with Hensel Phelps, \$9,850,000 in Parks & Recreation General Obligation Bond funds was allocated for the design and construction of a new locker room building that includes family restroom, weight room, lifeguard and first aid station, administrative support offices, meeting rooms, timing/scoring rooms, and other associated amenities.
