

A certificate of insurance must be approved by the city risk manager prior to the issuance or renewal of any permit.

Sec. 27-230. Insurance.

For each non-motorized vehicle there shall be maintained a policy or policies of public liability insurance with a combined single limit for death, bodily injury and property damage liability of at least fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) per person and one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) per occurrence. All such insurance policies shall be written by companies authorized to transact business in the state. A certificate of insurance indicating the liability amounts and the policy period must be filed with the license division and approved by the city risk manager prior to issuance or renewal of any permit. All such policies shall be kept in full force and effect at all times any non-motorized vehicle is operated within the city.



Mission Statement

Cycle Party USA strives to provide environmentally sound and healthy entertainment at a fair price, promoting relaxed and enjoyable quality time for friends, families and colleagues, always operating in a safe and respectful way.

What is Cycle Party?

Cycle Party is a 100% green, pedal powered group event on four wheels. The Cycle Party group bike is 16 1/2 feet long and 8 1/2 feet high and seats 15 guests around a center table under a rooftop. It has been custom built at a cost of \$30,000.00. It takes at least 6 persons pedaling, in order for it to move comfortably. For a group of 15 the cost per person is between \$21 and \$35 plus tax per tour.

Who is "Cycle Party?"

Cycle Party is owned by long time South Florida residents Michael Haerting and his wife Aileen Brousseau. Their son Christopher Haerting heads day-to-day operations. Michael retired in 2010 after 10 years working for the Continental Group, where he was responsible for a quarter of the Miami-Dade luxury condo portfolio with over 10,000 apartments and over 1,000 employees. Michael holds an MBA in international management and has been honored by the City of Miami Beach for his volunteer work in Haiti following the earthquake.

What is a Group Bike?

Our group bike is a quadracycle, which is defined as a human-powered land vehicle. Human-powered quadracycles have been in use since 1853 and have grown into several families of vehicles for a variety of purposes, including tourist rentals referred to as surreys, pedal taxis, private touring, and group or party bikes.

Group bikes were developed in Holland about 10 years ago. Now there are hundreds of such bikes operating daily in over 50 cities all over Europe. (About 150 in Germany alone). In the USA such bikes are in operation since 2006. Now 31 companies with over 100 bikes give tours in 40 cities in 25 states.

Proposed Routes

Routes are proposed by Cycle Party and have to be approved by the City. The routes will avoid high-traffic areas and should minimize interference with automobile traffic.

When booking Cycle Party, groups have a choice of those predetermined routes. All tours begin and end at the same location. Cycle Party tours typically run 2 hours and stop only at previously agreed upon location.

Safety and Traffic Concerns

Cycle Party shares the road as a bicycle but will pull over to let faster traffic pass. Cycle Party will not travel on any roads with a speed limit higher than 30mph. The proposed routes will only cross such roads where absolutely necessary and only at traffic lights. Cycle Party obeys all traffic laws.

A trained company driver always steers the bike and has complete control of the brakes, lights and direction signals. The hydraulic brake system overrides the pedaling of the passengers. The driver is trained to control the behavior of the passengers.

Cycle Party is only aware of one accident in Germany where a woman injured herself getting off the bike.

Insurance and Liability

Cycle Party carries liability insurance of \$1,000,000 per incident and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate and names the City as co-insured.

The riders must be at least 18 years old (or 16-18 with a release signed by a legal guardian), and 21 if the stops include bars. All riders must sign a release of liability and agree to the rules regarding safety and conduct. Cycle Party offers helmets for those who would like to wear them.

Who Books Cycle Party?

Both tourists and residents book tours for sight seeing, progressive dinners, birthdays, bachelor parties, church outings, fund raisers, festivals, exercise classes, family reunions, pub crawls and singles mixers.

Cycle Party also targets corporations and organizations for unique team building, group rewards, and promotional opportunities.

Summary

Cycle Party aims to provide fun, healthy, non-polluting, environmentally sound tours for up to 15 residents or tourists at a time on a group-bike.

This concept has been operating in the US for over 6 years and is already established in many other cities: Baltimore, Cincinnati, Portland, Austin, Denver, Honolulu, Flagstaff, Tucson and Raleigh, to name a few.

Cycle Party will not serve food or drinks but instead partners with local cafes, bars and restaurants.

Cycle Party Release of Liability Form All riders must provide a photo ID at the time of their tour, and must read and sign the Release of Liability Form.

Cycle Party under 18 years of age Release of Liability Form Parents or Guardians of youths between 16 and 18 years of age participating on a tour must read and sign this Release of Liability form.

- The Pilot is in charge of the tour and will only take directions from the Renter, the person who paid for the Party.
- No glass containers on the group bike
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the group bike in accordance with City ordinances.
- No umbrellas on the group bike.
- · Helmets are offered, in accordance with Florida State Law your choice if you're over 16.
- No leaving the Cycle Party group bike or jumping off while in motion. Planned and announced stops only.
- Respect our streets and our town, no littering or excess noise please.
- Your Pilot, a trained Cycle Party employee, is the only individual who can drive the bike.
- Insurance regulations require everyone to be 18 or older (16 with approval of parents; 21 on pub crawls). ID's are checked at time of departure.
- All Party Guests must sign a release of liability form prior to riding the bike.
- There are no refunds due to poor weather.

Unless it is a severe weather situation, we will ride. If severe weather does occur, Cycle Party reserves the right to cancel the Cycle Party tour and offer you a rain check. We also offer a rain check if the Cycle Party has to be canceled due to weather within the first hour of the tour. Rain checks have to be used in the following 12 months. Examples of severe weather may include but are not limited to: High wind advisory: typically over 30mph or severe thunderstorms with heavy lightning.

- · Cycle Party is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items while on the group bike.
- All rules of the road apply to the Cycle Party while in motion; your Pilot will help everyone stick to them.
- Please have a designated driver for the ride home after any consumption of alcohol.
 Don't drink and drive.
- Damage Fees and/or Late Fees may be assessed.

There will be no Damage/Late Fee charged if the Cycle Party group bike returns to the starting point on time and undamaged from the Cycle Party.

We reserve the right to charge your credit card following the tour if necessary. Since the Cycle Party is powered by its passengers, they control the speed at which the tour progresses. For scheduling purposes, however, it is necessary that the tour end within 15 minutes of the scheduled return time. The pilot will determine if late fees are applicable. Traffic, outside of passengers control will be taken into consideration.
