Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Motion granting a Waiver for a watercraft concession to operate in the beach boating restricted zone for Doctor Jet Ski of Fort Lauderdale, Inc., at the Ocean Sky Hotel, 4060 Galt Ocean Drive.

Background

The applicant is seeking a Motion granting a Waiver (a waiver to allow operate a watercraft concession (**Exhibits 1 & 2**) via a 50' foot wide marked launch corridor within the beach boating restricted zone) as provided under the provisions of the Sections 8-170 through 8-177, Code of Ordinances (**Exhibit 3**). Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required. The applicant's proposed watercraft concession would be replacing a previous concession, offering wave runner, paddle board, kayak, and banana boat rentals. A letter from the owner of the Ocean Sky Hotel and Resort indicates watersport concessions have operated at this location since at least 1991.

In a voice vote, the Marine Advisory Board recommended approval of the application (13:0) (Exhibit 4)
