Due to the success of the Loyalty Program and the recognition that some cities were unable to complete their procurement process in time to meet earlier deadlines, Wheelabrator is now offering the $\$ 2 /$ ton financial incentive to cities and towns that, prior to June 30, 2013, either (i) approve the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) dated September 1, 2012 with Broward County for Solid Waste Disposal Support Services and choose Wheelabrator to be its provider for solid waste disposal services, or (ii) approve a contract for solid waste disposal services with a term of at least 5 years directly with Wheelabrator or an affiliate through other procurement methods permitted by their municipal code, in each case for all of its municipal solid waste.
