**TITLE:** Resolution approving a Local Agency Program Agreement with the Florida  
Department of Transportation for construction of the Flagler Drive  
Greenway and Bicycle Facility Phase II – P11818

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution authorizing the proper City officials to execute a Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to receive grant funds in the amount of \$988,402 for the Flagler Drive Greenway and Bicycle Facility Phase II.

**Background**

The City's of Public Works Department completed Phase I of the Flagler Drive Greenway and Bicycle Facility Project in January 2013. The roadway was reduced from four (4) travel lanes to two (2) travel lanes, and a shared pathway was installed on Flagler Drive from Andrews Avenue to Sunrise Boulevard. The Public Works Department has proceeded with the design and preparation of construction documents for Phase II of the project.

The scope of the Phase II includes the installation of new pedestrian lighting on both sides of Flagler Drive from Andrews Avenue to Sunrise Boulevard and construction of new bio-swale drainage with landscaping. FDOT will fund the total estimated cost for the construction of \$988,402 (\$909,652 for construction and \$78,750 for Construction Engineering Inspection services).

**Resource Impact**

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$988,402 associated with this action. The grant does not require a cash match. Funds are being appropriated through CAM 14-0236.
