TITLE: Purchase, Installation, and Trade-in of Boat Engines - \$38,971.59

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase and installation of two boat engines from the single bidder, Parker Yacht Management, LLC, utilizing the City's Contract (Form P-0001) in the amount of \$41,971.59; and authorize conveying two boat engines to Parker Yacht Management, LLC as trade-in for a credit in the amount of \$3,000.

Background

The Police Marine Unit needs to replace the two oldest engines in their fleet which are 2006 models that were purchased in 2008 and have been out of warranty since 2011. Boat No. 4 port motor has recorded 3,783 hours and the starboard motor has recorded 3,782 hours. Even though these motors are 2006 models, the hours are indicative of motors that are approaching 37 years in age. This is based on the Yamaha standard that 100 hours is equal to one year's use. The maintenance costs for these two engines over the last 24 months were \$9,228.

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid Number 452-11531 for the purchase and installation of boat engines and received one bid. Pursuant to Section 2-182, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, single bids over \$25,000 must be approved by the City Commission. The cost to purchase and install the two engines is \$41,971.59. Parker Yacht Management, LLC's net bid includes a credit of \$3,000 for the two trade-in engines. Pursuant to Section 2-197.(c), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, supplies may be exchanged for or traded in on new supplies.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$38,971.59
