TITLE: Introduce Ordinance on first reading, amending Code of Ordinances –

Section 2-127 – approval of change orders, additions or task orders

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt an ordinance amending the City Code, Chapter 2, Administration, Article IV, Division 2, Engineering Division of Public Works, to amend the Commission approval values from over \$10,000 to over \$25,000 for change orders, additions or task orders and to establish definitions thereto; and providing an effective date, and providing that the City Manager may approve change orders, additions or task orders up to \$25,000.

Background

On December 4, 2012 (CAM 12-2581, BUS-4) staff presented additional approval threshold amendments to the Purchasing Ordinance for discussion to be in accordance with other City Manager approval values. In accordance with Commission direction approval values for Section 2-127 — City Commission approval of change orders, additions or task orders would increase for amounts over \$25,000 and the City Manager may approve change orders, additions or task orders up to \$25,000 as outlined in Exhibit 1, Ordinance No. C-13-.
