Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a one-year unit cost contract with two, one-year extensions for project 11744 annual ocean regulatory buoys replacement to the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder, American Underwater Contractors, Inc., in the estimated amount of \$59,950, and authorize the City Manager to approve all renewal options contingent upon approval and appropriation of funds.

Background

The scope of this contract includes the installation of ocean vessel exclusion buoys at specified locations where they are damaged or missing. The City has placed these buoys along the shore of our beaches as a safety measure and protection to our residents and visitors from vessels traveling in the ocean.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$70,150. \$59,950 is available for the work orders and \$10,200 is available for associated engineering fees.
