TITLE:	Motion Approving Annual Contract for Concrete Sidewalk and Paver Stones – Team Contracting Inc \$1,800,000 (two-year total) – (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an annual contract, in substantially the form attached, with Team Contracting Inc., for concrete sidewalk and paver stones in the estimated amount of \$1,800,000 (two-year total), and authorize the City Manager to approve two, one-year renewal options, contingent upon the appropriation of funds.

Background

This is a two-year contract with work to be performed on a task order basis. Work will include, but is not limited to, installation of 6-inch thick concrete sidewalk, various curbs, brick pavers, limerock base of various depths, asphalt, thermoplastic pavement marking, Americans with Disabilities Act concrete ramps, tree root pruning and other items quantified in the proposal pages of this contract.

On October 6, 2015, the City Commission approved the citywide sidewalk inspection and management system repair priority plan to address damaged sidewalks identified in the damage assessment previously performed by Atkins North America, Inc. (CAM 15-0589). The intent of this contract is to continue addressing damaged sidewalks; however, it will also be utilized to construct improvements in or adjacent to City facilities, and will be a resource for any projects requiring the unit bid items for construction of public improvements.

On December 24, 2019, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid, Number 12352-403. Three bids were received on January 23, 2020 with two firms being responsive, and also indicating their status as a Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise, or Small Business Enterprise. One firm did not include an offer which rendered it non-responsive. The bid submitted by Team Contracting Inc., met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal year impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$978,000 for the contract and \$100,000 for estimated in-house project management fees for a total cost of \$1,078,000, which is available in the FY2020 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below. Future expenditures are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.
