TITLE: Reimagining City Hall Workshops - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

At the August 22, 2023 Joint Commission Workshop with the Infrastructure Task Force (ITF) Advisory Committee, the City Commission requested that the ITF outline guiding principles and propose a vision to guide future decision making on the development of a new City Hall. The ITF, in partnership with the Office of Management and Budget, Dickey Consulting Services, Inc., and the American Institute of Architects student chapter at Florida Atlantic University, conducted extensive outreach with neighbors through a series of five public workshops and surveys to better understand community needs and desires for a new City Hall.

A detailed summary of the facilitated workshops and associated survey results are provided in Exhibit 1. Additionally, employee input was also collected through an employee survey and town hall workshop about what employees would need and want from a new City facility to be most productive and efficient. A summary of that workshop and associated survey is provided in Exhibit 2.
