

- Walk-On May 7, 2013 Motion approving a short-term lease for a temporary Re: health and wellness center (\$3,300.34 per month)

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a short-term lease (\$3,300.34 per month) for a medical office building to be used as a temporary health and wellness center at 300 SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale. This temporary facility will be used while the permanent health and wellness center at 105 NE 3<sup>rd</sup> Street is under construction to convert the location from an office building into a medical facility.

## Background

The original contract for Marathon Health to operate the new center for the City was approved by the Commission on October 2, 2012. Subsequently, the Commission approved a lease contract for the permanent facility on March 19, 2013. Due to the necessary construction on the permanent building, staff believed it was in the best interest of the City to accommodate health plan members by locating and opening a temporary center during the permanent structure's construction phase.

Staff found a facility owned by Broward Health that will meet the City's needs as a temporary site. The 1,686 square-foot temporary facility is directly across the street from the Broward Health Emergency Room entrance. It is currently vacant but was being used as a physician's office. Broward Health will eventually raze this building in conjunction with their plans for a new health complex.

Opening a temporary health and wellness center is well within the project's budget. In fact, the lease with Broward Health for the temporary site is \$532.16 per month less than the budgeted expense for the permanent site (\$3,300.34 versus \$3,832.50). In addition, the temporary site will allow members more immediate access to the financial and medical benefits of the health and wellness center.

## **Resource Impact**

The lease term is for 60 days with three (3) one (1) month options to renew. The funding for a temporary Health Center (2 months at \$3,300.34 per month) is estimated to be \$6,600.68.
