## **RESOLUTION NO. 24-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS FOR THE SHARING AND SAFEGUARDING OF SENSITIVE AND CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DATA AND INFORMATION, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, RESCISSION OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTION PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 4.01(b) of the City Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale requires that Mayor, City Manager, City Attorney and City Clerk execute all contracts, agreements or other instruments to which the City is a party under which the City assumes any liability; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter further provides that the City Commission has the authority to delegate by resolution to another person the authority to execute these instruments; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission hereby delegates authority to the City Manager to execute all contracts and agreements for the sharing and safeguarding of sensitive and confidential information technology data and information, on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, such documents shall still be attested by the city clerk and approved as to form by the city attorney or assistant city attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

- <u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Manager of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida is hereby delegated the authority to execute contracts and agreements for the sharing and safeguarding of sensitive and confidential information technology data and information, on behalf of the City.
- <u>SECTION 2</u>. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by the City Manager.
- <u>SECTION 3</u>. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.
