TITLE: Motion to approve additional funds to an existing contract with Sun-Up Enterprises, Inc. for Walkability and other Transportation and Mobility Department Projects in the amount of \$460,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve additional funds to an existing contract with Sun-Up Enterprises, Inc., in the amount of \$460,000 (Exhibit 1) for design and construction of projects to include, but not limited to: pedestrian improvements at NE 3rd Avenue and NE 1st Street; N Andrews Avenue and NE 1st Street; Las Olas Boulevard at 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Avenues; Broward Boulevard and SE 1st Avenue; bike and pedestrian improvements to NE/NW 4th Street from US 1 to Avenue of the Arts; and pedestrian improvements along Dixie Highway.

Background

The agreement (Exhibit 2) with Sun-Up Enterprises, Inc. was approved in October 15, 2013 after a competitive procurement process. The total contract amount is \$1,913,000 based on unit pricing, with \$195,000 authorized to date. Additional funds need to be authorized beyond the \$195,000 to advance the Downtown Walkability projects, and other department projects such as the Dixie Highway Crosswalk project.

The contract addresses upgrades that will be used to bring City facilities into ADA compliance and for other improvements to the roadway and pedestrian realm. The contract is set up for construction, repair and upgrade to City surface parking lots and on-street parking, sidewalks, and other public facilities, speed humps and other traffic calming measures, installation of enhanced crosswalks and associated features, various signage, installation of the multimodal connectivity map elements, right-of-way and drainage improvements throughout the City, when needed.

Resource Impact

There is an estimated fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$460,000. Funds are available in the current fiscal year.
