**TITLE:** Motion to award the purchase of IBM Informix support renewal and licenses – Invitation to Bid (ITB) 743-11303 - \$56,716.12

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission award the purchase of IBM Informix support renewal and licenses from the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder, Dataskill, Inc. in the amount of \$56,716.12.

**Background**

Many of the City's applications utilize the Informix Database Management System (utility billing, code enforcement, business tax licenses, permitting, alarm billing, fire safety inspections, police overtime records, etc.). These applications incorporate Informix to store and maintain all of the information (data) associated with their computer programs.

On October 8, 2013, Invitation to Bid 743-11303 was opened with 4 bids received. The low bidder, Dataskill, Inc., has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

**Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$56,716.12.
