

# CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE PUBLIC NOTICE PROPOSED PROGRAM AMENDMENT

The City of Fort Lauderdale is considering amending its 2012-2013 Annual Action Plan of the 2010-2015 Consolidated Plan. In accordance with the Substantial Change Policy of the City's HUD approved Consolidated Plans, this change requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plans. A change in the Housing Opportunities for Persons with HIV/AIDS (HOPWA) assisted activity as a result of the addition or cancellation of a program or a change in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiary of an activity, requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan. The City of Fort Lauderdale's program amendment and substantial change policy requires Commission Approval and public input at a public hearing after proper notice has been published for a 30-day public comment period.

This amendment identifies how the City Commission anticipates allocating the 2012-2013 HOPWA funds. The proposed allocation of the 2012-2013 HOPWA funds are as follows:

In accordance with federal regulations, the City is hereby establishing a 30-day public comment period to receive input on the proposed amendment to its Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan. Comments on the proposed change(s) may be submitted to the City of Fort Lauderdale, Community Development Division, 700 N.W. 19th Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33311. Public comments on this item will be accepted during the 30-day public comment period from September 24, 2012 to October 23, 2012. All comments must be received by October 23, 2012. The City will evaluate all comments received during the comment period, and the final amendment will be submitted to the Commission at a public hearing on November 6, 2012, which will be held in the City Commission Chambers in City Hall located at 100 North Andrews Avenue at 6:00 p.m. Public input will also be accepted at this public hearing on this amendment. A copy of the final amendment will be available for public review at the Community Development Division at the above address during regular office hours. At the close of the public hearing, the City Commission will consider a motion approving the program amendment to the Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan.
