Background

Sharon Sisk Robinson, a former Fort Lauderdale Police Department employee, filed a workers' compensation claim for injuries that occurred on August 28, 1998, while in the course and scope of employment with the City.

Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$125,000 subject to the approval of the City Commission.
